<u>Middle School Supplies - Grades 6-8</u> 2019-2020

Please have the items listed below with you on the first day of school, and <u>be prepared to replenish some of these</u> <u>supplies as they run out throughout the school year</u>. - 1 three-subject spiral notebook with a durable cover
- 12 pencils with erasers (wood or mechanical)*
- 6 black or blue pens AND 6 red pens gel or ballpoint (non-permanent and non-clicking)*
- 2 correction tapes (non-liquid)
- 2 reams (500 sheets each) of computer paper
- 1 package college ruled binder paper*
- 8-tab binder dividers w/pockets
- 2 packs of 3x5 index cards (ruled)
- 3-ring binder (3" minimum please)
- 1 supply bag to keep pens, pencils, etc. organized in the backpack or binder
- 1 box of Kleenex for classroom supply
- Reusable water bottle
- <u>Four</u> hardcover textbooks will need to be covered in the first week of school. Book Sox or something similar are a good option, but please buy the jumbo size. You are also welcome to make covers at home using brown paper bags or something similar.
- 2 durable folders with side pockets to use as covers for soft-cover books
- If your last name begins with letters **A-J ONLY**: 1 container of Lysol (or similar type) disinfecting wipes
- If your last name begins with letters K-R ONLY: 1 large bottle of hand sanitizer
- If your last name begins with letters S-V ONLY: 1 box of multi-size Band-aids
