

Grade 7 Supplies 2017-2018

Welcome to 7th Grade! I hope you are looking forward to the coming school year as much as I am, but for now I hope are enjoying summer more than anything! Please have the items listed below with you on the first day of school, and be prepared to replenish some of these supplies as they run out throughout the school year. You know how big the desks are, so please keep that limited amount of space in mind as you shop.

- 1 3-subject notebook with durable cover
- 12 pencils with erasers (wood or mechanical)
- 6 blue or black ballpoint pens (non-clicking)*
- 6 red correcting ballpoint pens (non-clicking)*
- 1 box colored pencils (24 count minimum)
- 1 pack of college ruled binder paper
- 1 durable pencil sharpener for your desk (no battery powered ones, please)
- 2 correction tapes (not liquid, please)
- 1 durable accordion file folder (many come with 13 pockets - that is perfect. All assignments and non-electronic communication will come home & back to school in this)
- 1 small plastic pencil box or durable supply bag
- 2 packages of copy paper (500 sheets each)
- 2 boxes of Kleenex for our classroom supply
- All hardcover textbooks will need to be covered in the first week of school. If you/your child want to use Book Sox or something similar, please buy the jumbo size. However, you are also welcome to make covers at home using brown paper grocery bags or similar materials. Four books will need to be covered.
- If your last name begins with A-L: 1 bottle of Purell hand sanitizer
- If you last name begins with M-Z: 1 container of Lysol or similar disinfecting wipes

*These items will be used on a daily basis and will need to be replenished from home throughout the year. I never want to hear, "I don't have..." one of these items!

Please do not bring...

- Liquid paper (White Out or something similar)
- Sharpies or any permanent markers
- Metallic pens
- Binders
- Tape of any kind
