

## Grade 7 Supplies

2018-2019

Welcome to 7th Grade! I hope you are looking forward to the coming school year as much as I am, but for now I hope are enjoying summer more than anything! Please have the items listed below with you on the first day of school, and be prepared to replenish some of these supplies as they run out throughout the school year. You know how big the desks are, so please keep that limited amount of space in mind as you shop.

- 3 single subject spiral notebooks with durable covers
- 12 pencils with erasers (wood or mechanical)\*
- 6 black or blue pens AND 6 red pens – gel or ballpoint (non-permanent and non-clicking)\*
- 1 correction tape (non-liquid)
- 1 box of colored pencils (24 count minimum)
- 2 reams (500 sheets each) of computer paper
- 1 pack of college ruled binder paper
- 2 packs of 3x5 index cards (ruled)
- 1 durable pencil sharpener for your desk
- Some type of durable organizational tool for papers (homework, graded work, etc.) – accordion file, binder, folders – choose something you will use!
- 1 small plastic pencil box or supply bag
- 1 box of Kleenex for our classroom supply
- Small reusable water bottle
- All hardcover textbooks will need to be covered in the first week of school. If you/your child wants to use Book Sox or something similar, please buy the jumbo size. However, you are also welcome to make covers at home using brown paper bags or something similar. They will need to cover 4 books.
- If your last name begins with letters A-J ONLY: 1 container of Lysol (or similar type) disinfecting wipes
- If your last name begins with letters K-R ONLY: 1 large bottle of hand sanitizer
- If your last name begins with letters S-V ONLY: 1 box of multi-size Band-aids

\*These items will be used on a daily basis and will need to be replenished as needed throughout the year from home. I never want to hear, “I don’t have...” one of these items!

Please **do not bring**...

1. Liquid paper (White Out)
2. Permanent or metallic markers (NO SHARPIES!!!)
3. Binders
4. Tape of any kind
