Dear St. Vincent de Paul Parents,

The successful healthy cooking classes begin on September  $24^{th}$ . This is a monthly component of our PE program and sponsored by CYO. We know the students will enjoy this activity while learning about nutrition and cooking.

As you can see, many programs and activities are underway, all of which add to our St. Vincent de Paul community. We continue to ask God to bless our endeavors and keep you and your families healthy and safe.

The fee is \$10 a month, September through June, so please attach a check made to **SVDP Parish** (not SVDP School). The fee for the school year is \$90 per student.

Rehearsals continue on Fridays after school, 3:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. Boys Choir members sing at the church on the first Saturday of the month, unless there are conflicts or holiday weekends, in which case another Saturday will be designated. Boys will receive a snack each Friday, as has been the custom.

The first rehearsal will be on Friday, September 13th.

The first Mass will be the "Back to School" Mass on Saturday evening,

September 14th. Warm-up in the school music room at 4:30 p.m. please.

The co-principals and Mr. Meyer have agreed that the typical age for choir members will be Second through Eighth grade - we want to encourage older boys to continue and not give the impression that the choir only a "little boys" program. Boys voices are at their peak when they are 10-11-12 years old, so that is a target age for membership by boys. Younger boys can learn, older boys can mentor, but for a really good sound, we need the medium age range boys.

Boys in First Grade this year who sang in the choir last year may enroll again (or join the GGBC as an alternate). We will not be passing out forms to boys in K or Ist grades who were not already members last year.

I am looking forward to working with your son(s) again this year and hope to see older boys returm, and newer boys enroll.

Looking toward December 2015, when we have a goal to sing for Pope Francis in Rome at the Vatican on New Year's Day, January 1, 2016. This is the next International Boy Choir Congress in Rome.
