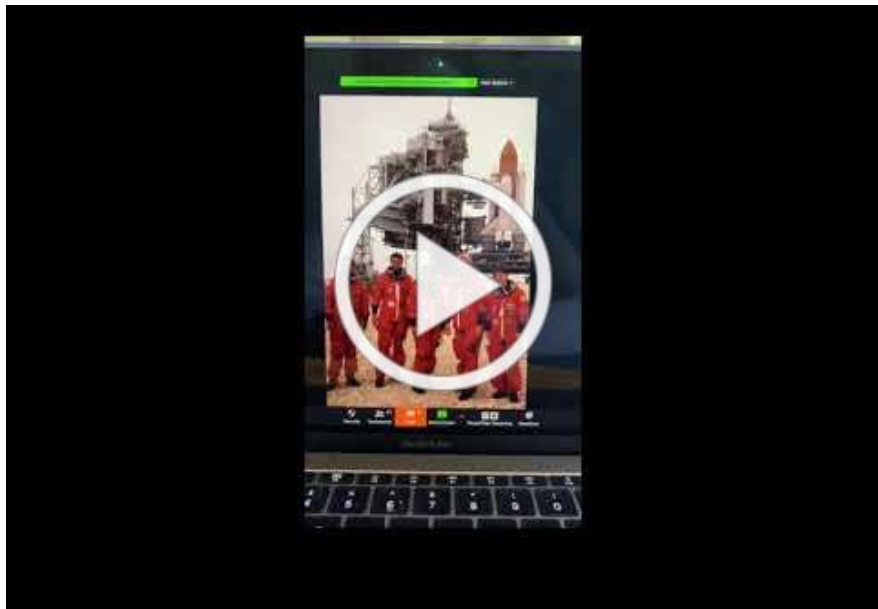

4th Grade Blasts Off!

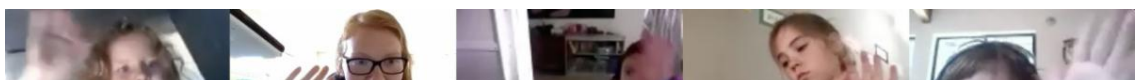

4th Grade meets with NASA Scientist

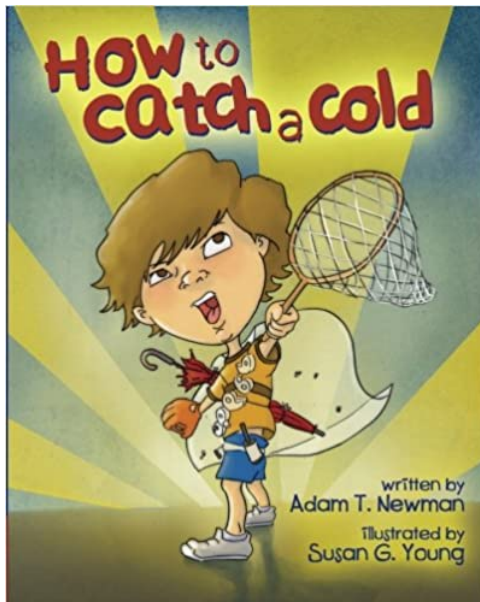
1st Grade Explores a Distant Butterfly

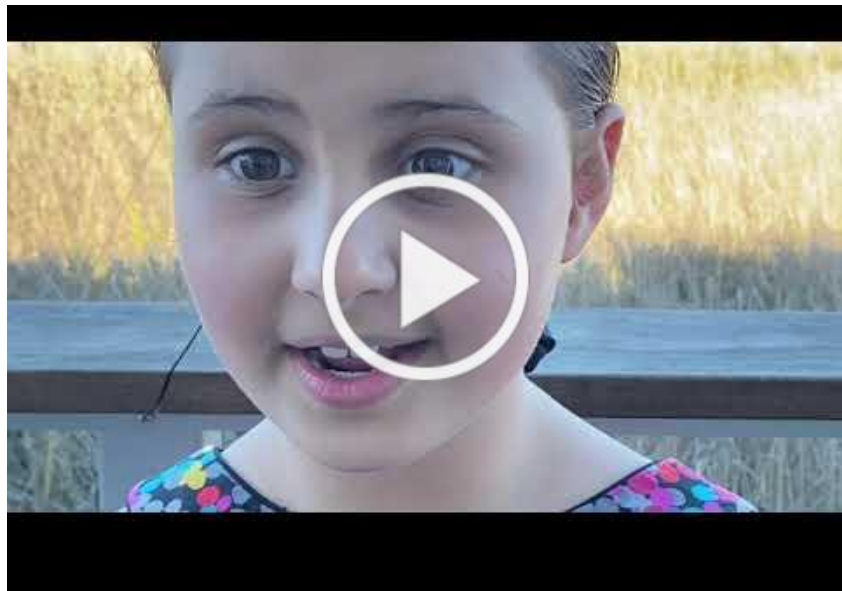
