Dear Parents,

Starting this year, all enrollment will be completed online. This process streamlines enrollment management, minimizes error, and provides us with accurate and updated Emergency and Safety Information for each child at school.

Enrollment agreements are due by March 2nd. Please do not delay. After March 2nd, we will begin accepting students who have already applied from our wait pool. We certainly hope that every student returns next year, but want to make sure we can plan for any foreseeable changes.

All Tuition (even if paid by check) will be processed through FACTS (our tuition management system). This step helps us to ensure accurate accounting and to further reduce our reliance on paper whenever possible.

When your registration is complete, you will receive a notice from Beehively.

You will then be sent instructions from Shanna Rodgers, Accounting Specialist, regarding FACTS.

The online enrollment process will take approximately 15 minutes. Please complete each section to secure your child's space for next year.

A Note on Gun Violence in Schools

Presentation School adds its own prayers to the millions more who are grieving the senseless violence of school shootings across the country. While thoughts and prayers are essential, we are focused on our own students' safety and well being.

This fall, the school conducted an emergency response audit with Joffe Emergency Services. This process reinforced our own emergency plans and added additional steps and protocols to consider.

Last month, we changed bathroom locks as security step. We have re-keyed doors, installed dead bolts in rooms, and added shades to library doors. All rooms are supplied with emergency backpacks. We test our in-school and home-school emergency systems and regularly practice lock down, shelter in place, earthquake and fire drills.

While we are confident in our emergency protocols and procedures, we are committed to being prepared for all eventualities. Your children's safety is our first priority and we will continue to work towards creating a campus that is both safe, as well as welcoming and child-centered.

Please assure your children that they are known, loved, precious and safe at school.




