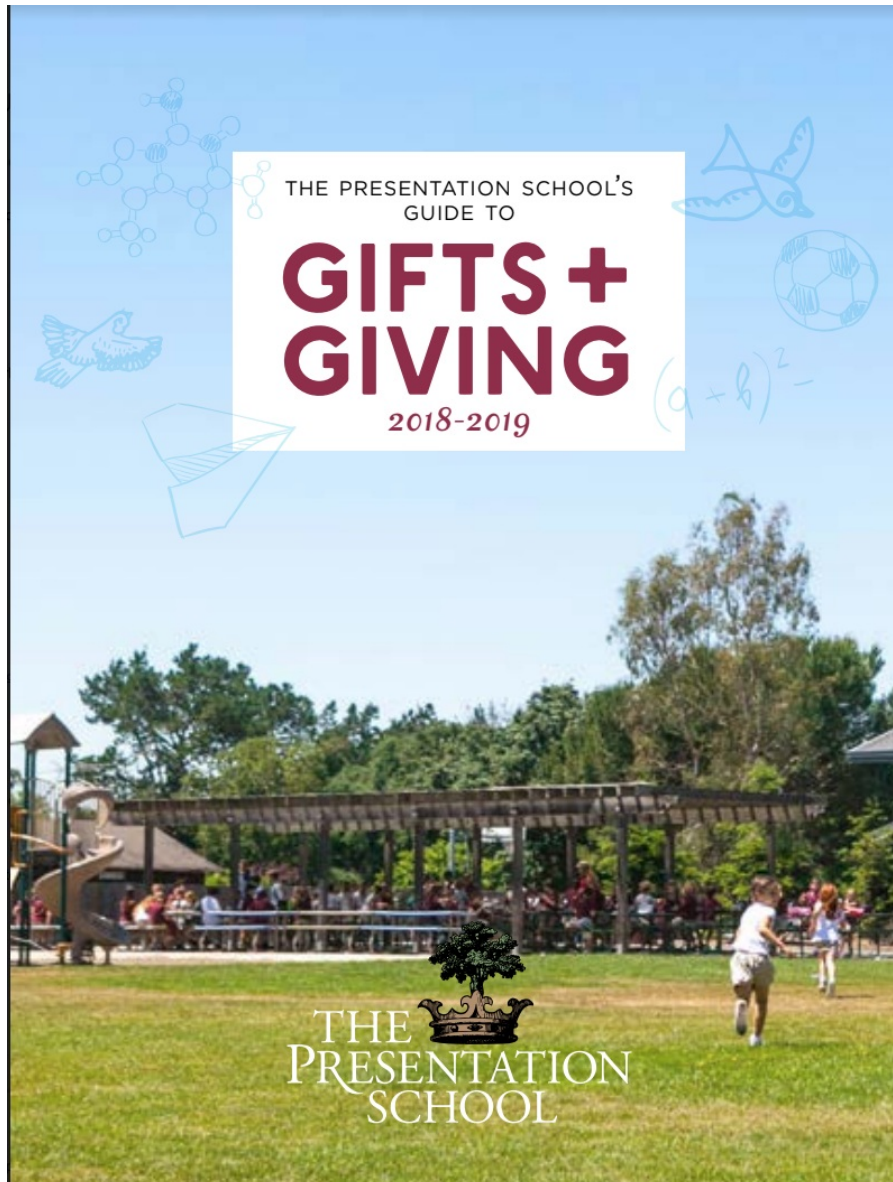

**This Tuesday, 8/21 "Hair Fairies" will return to campus
to screen all students for head lice.**

Technicians will check each student for head lice and nits (eggs). If either are present, a sample will be collected and kept for you to view- this helps to clarify what to look for when screening at home. We will call you if lice and/or nits are found on your child, and ask that they be picked up from school. We recommend that you have them professionally treated, after which point they may return to school (the following day).

The technicians on campus will only aid in the screening for lice/nits, no treatment is provided.

Visit the [Hair Fairies website](#). They provide basic information, prevention tips, and treatment solutions for head lice. I've also added a few other websites for local treatment options, some of which even provide in-home treatment.

If your family dealing with lice, please know you're in good company with this particular nuisance. Lice is as common as the common cold, and will visit between 6-12 million families with kids between ages of 3-11 annually. They thrive in clean hair, so an outbreak it is not an indicator of poor or neglected hygiene.

We will invite Hair Fairies back at the beginning of the second semester to help aid in the screening process.
