**How do we find peace within ourselves?**

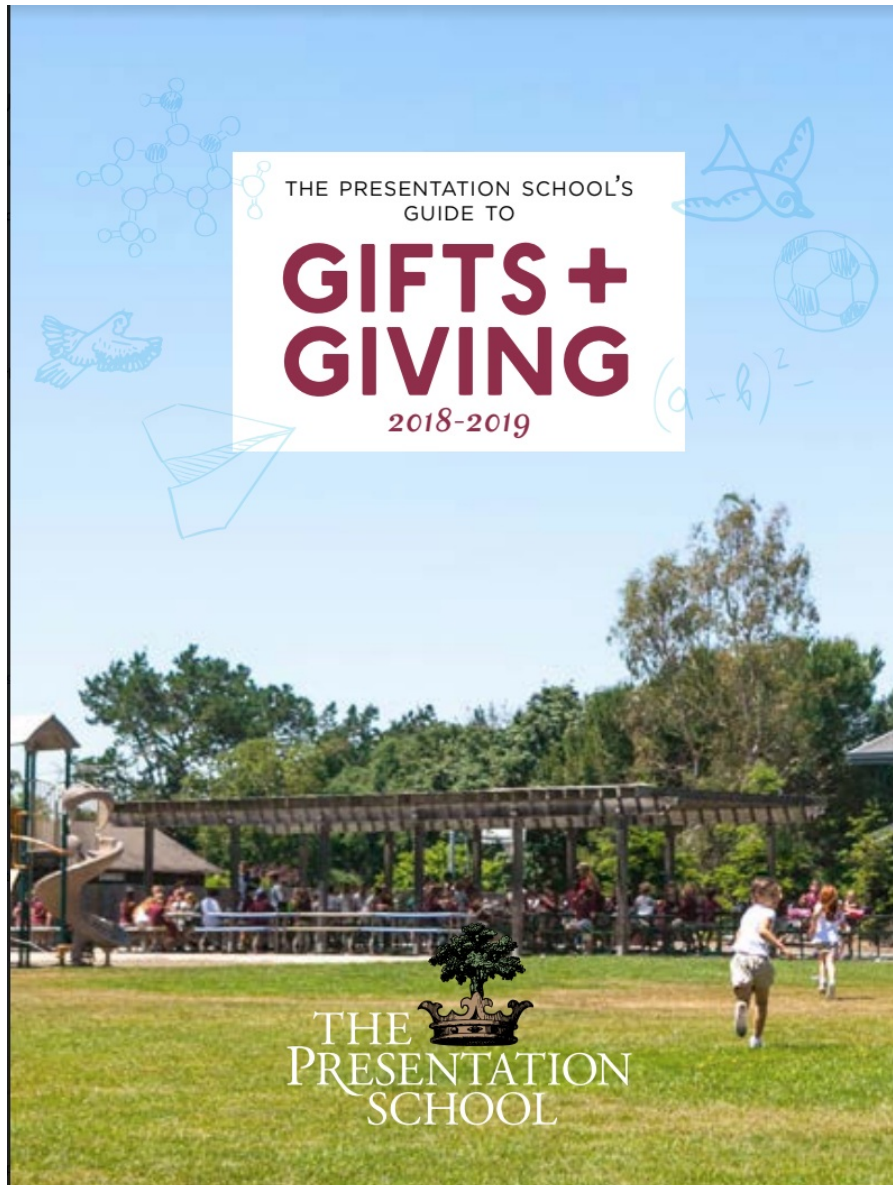

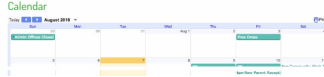
