Welcome Back to Campus! We look forward to all students and staff returning to St. Rose School campus on Tuesday, September 8th! We are excited to welcome all students back in full uniform and masks!

September Minimum Days and No School/Extension Days

- Friday, September 18th - Minimum Day (TK: 8am-11:30am & K-8: 8am-12pm)
- Friday, September 27th - No School or Extension

All School Loop Please enter and exit school through the loop. Upon entering the back loop gate please have students have their masks on before they exit their car.

Arrival Loop: Large Loop Gate opens 7:35am; form one line around outside of Loop for drop-off of children.

- Cars circle Loop; drop students off at the curb (cones) behind the church
- TK and Kinder Teachers will wait on the cement area behind the church for their students to arrive. Morning loop duty volunteers will walk these children to their teachers.
- Parents depart via large gate

Dismissal Loop: Large Loop Gate opens 2:40pm; form two lanes around the outside of Loop.

- Drivers take turns merging to form a pick-up line along the curb.
- Drivers pull all the way up to the priests' garage (6-7 cars fit along the curb)
- Children will be watching for their cars and be ready to enter their car when drivers come to a stop along the curb.

Medication Forms New forms are available in the school office or on SchoolSpeak<School Forms<[Administration Of Medicine During School Hours By School Personnel](#). A reminder that ALL medications, this includes over the counter medicines, must have a current school release form on file for medicines to be administered by school personnel. Students are prohibited from having any medications on their person or from bringing them into the classroom with them. Medications must be kept in the school office. A new form MUST be completed by a physician and parent each school year.

Emergency Cards All hard copy (paper) emergency cards were sent home for a parent signature the week of August 17th. **All signed paper emergency cards must be returned to the school office no later than Friday, September 4th.** Please Note: In order for St. Rose School to have the most up to date and complete information, any changes you made on this emergency card must also be made in your family's individual profiles on SchoolSpeak.

Virtual Back to School Night We will hold two Back to School nights, one night for on campus, in-person learning students and one night for at-home learning students. Both nights will have two sessions per teacher; 5:30pm-5:50pm and 6:00pm-6:20pm. Zoom links will be provided to you by the teacher's weekly newsline.

- In-person learning students: Tuesday, September 15
- At-home learning students: Wednesday, September 16

Parent Volunteers at School If you plan to volunteer on campus, field trips*, or coaching* you must have all clearances up-to-date and on file in the school office. These include: DOJ Fingerprint (good for as long as you are a parent at St. Rose School), Safe Haven (good for 3 years) and TB Test (good for 4 years). If you are unsure or have questions, please contact the school office. *We are allowing for all possibilities during this school year. Parents will be prepared with up-to-date clearances no matter what the year holds.

Sports News Over the past few months our athletic directors have been in communication with the PAL directors regarding what the 2020-21 PAL Sports year will look like. Unfortunately, we haven't had any definitive information to share. We did receive the attached "tentative" schedule for the 2020-21 PAL Sports Season. Like all things COVID related, we must caution all families that this could change. Right now we do know the following:

- PAL sports are currently "on pause" and are expected to remain on pause until December. "On pause" means no practice or training of any kind and no games.
- Pending State & County health directives, PAL sports might begin in December 2020.
- There will not be PAL flag football this year.

- All other PAL sports are expected to take place over 2 seasons. The breakdown and schedule timeline would be as follows:
 - Season #1 (December, January, & February): Boys & Girls Volleyball, Co-ed Cross Country, & Little Dribblers Basketball
 - Season #2 (March, April, & May): Boys & Girls Basketball, Co-ed Track, & Co-ed Golf

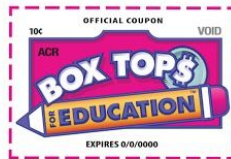
