2018-19 School Year School begins Monday, August 13 at 8am. Monday, August 13, Tuesday, August 14th, and Wednesday, August 15th are minimum days (TK: 8am-11:30am, K-8: 8am-12pm). If you children are attending Extension please bring a lunch from home. Students are to wear their school uniforms beginning the first day of school. Please join us for our opening day school Prayer Service at 9:30pm in the church.

Loop The first day of school the loop gate will be open at 7:35am for all student arrivals. Mrs. Heath & Mrs. Hunter will be at morning loop on the first day of school to welcome our TK and Kindergarten students. If you plan to come into the school, **please drop your children off at the curb before you park.**

The loop is designed to keep our children safe during arrival & departure from school. We ask that children arrive on time for school. **They must be in their classroom before the bell rings at 8am.**

Please follow our loop safety guidelines:

- It is imperative that drivers not exceed 5 mph while driving on campus
- Please make the loop cell phone free
- Children are to enter/exit vehicles from the curbside **ONLY**
- Drivers must remain in their vehicles while waiting in line
- If you plan to come into the office or to volunteer in the classrooms, **always** drop your children off in the loop before proceeding into the school through the office.
- Students may enter through the school office **only** if it is after the 8am school bell.
- If your children need assistance with projects and/or backpacks please drop your child off curbside, then proceed to park in the center, and walk the items to your children waiting curbside.
- The Church building is not to be used as an entrance/exit to school.
- The loop gate opens at 7:35am and 20 minutes prior to afternoon dismissal. Please do not arrive earlier than that as to keep congestion around our school minimal.
- Please do not block our driveway, but also the driveway's of our patient neighbors.

Hot Lunch & Milk Program Programs begin on our first full day of school, Thursday, August 16. To sign up for hot lunch go to SchoolSpeak<Quick Links<School House Catering or click [Schoolhouse Catering](#). The milk program cost for the 2018-19 school year is \$66.00. Please send checks to the office, payable to St. Rose School. If your child decides later in the year that they would like milk, the cost will be pro-rated.

Parent Volunteers at School If you plan to volunteer in the campus, field trips, or coaching you must have all clearances up-to-date and on file in the school office. These include: DOJ Fingerprint (good for as long as you are a parent at St. Rose School), Safe Haven (good for 3 years) and TB Test (good for 4 years). If you are unsure or have questions, please contact the school office.

Uniform Changes for 2018-19 Revisions-Additions-Deletions to the Handbook -- **Please be prepared.**
All uniform items MUST be properly fitting. Older siblings' old, ill-fitting sweatshirts may not be worn.

Dennis Uniform Co. Agreement:

Polo Shirts ONLY White (no crest) may be purchased elsewhere in bulk as families wish. GREY polo shirts **MUST** be purchased at Dennis.

Navy Blue Long Pants (girls and boys) may be purchased elsewhere but must be cotton Dockers style.

Vests & Three Quarter Zip Outerwear will be discontinued in 2019-20. Available while supplies last at Dennis Uniform Co. Store - Rancho Cordova, CA.

BOYS AND GIRLS

SHOES: ONLY ATHLETIC SHOES with good support (NO Converse, Vans, Mary Janes, Keds sneakers, etc.) **Please Note: Shoes must be Predominately BLACK OR WHITE or GREY (preferably solid black or white or grey).**

SOCKS: Plain, **all white** crew socks that cover the ankle bone.

P.E. SHORTS: Gr. 6-7-8 Required for P.E. / Gr. 1- 4 **NOT Required** but available for Little Dribblers

GIRLS

SOCKS: Girls Exception--white, black, or navy blue knee socks or "tights" with socks (**NOT LEGGINGS & No Long Johns or Pantyhose**) **NEW to 2018-19--NO LEGGINGS may be worn.** Tights or uniform long pants are available for cold days.

SKIRTS, JUMPERS, & SKORTS: MUST be hemmed to 2 inches above the knee.

NEW to 2018-19--UNDER-SKIRT GARMENT: Girls **MUST purchase** "bike shorts" (available at Old Navy or similar store & Dennis) for under skirts, jumpers etc. **NO gym shorts or other shorts** may be worn as an undergarment.

Extended Day Care

Extended Day Care (Extension) Extension opens on Monday, August 13, 2018 at 6:45am. Extension is open to all St. Rose students on school days from 6:45am-7:35am and the end of our school day until 6pm or when the last student is picked up. Extension program shadows the school's policies, procedures, and calendar. Students attending Extension must be registered (SchoolSpeak<Extended Day Registration 2018-19). Students must bring a lunch to Extension on minimum days.

Important points to note before the first day of school:

- Refer to your Extension registration agreement and the St. Rose School Parent/Student Handbook for vital specifics.
- Parents and students: safety and awareness of persons on campus at all times is a paramount concern. Parents/guardians or registered adults MUST sign in and out their children from Extension program, NO Exceptions!

Incoming Kindergarten

- Proof of immunizations - must be current with POLIO, DTP, MMR, HEPATITIS B series. Also required is either the VARICELLA immunization or date the child had chickenpox.

Incoming First Grade

- Proof of a physical exam done within 18 months of the start of first grade.

Incoming Seventh Grade

- Proof of TDap booster shot on or after their 10th birthday.
