The OLA Library is the literary home for all OLA students. It is a place to hear stories, for students to challenge themselves through all reading levels, for project research, for completing school work and is a comfortable, quiet place to meet.

Preschool to Fifth grade classes each have a weekly library period with our librarian, Mrs. Spinelli, for group story time, for checking out books and for building library skills. The Fourth and Fifth grade classes have, in addition, the Reading Literature Program, which is composed of small-group book clubs that meet weekly at the library.

The facility has a bank of computers, over 8000 book titles, a SMART Board and many spaces for collaboration. The upper-grades use the Library as a resource for research and collaboration on school projects.

The Library hosts two Book Fairs every year to provide families with a wide variety of affordable choices to enrich their own libraries. Additionally, the Library hosts the Jr. High Academic Decathlon Team, Study Hall, the Boy Scouts and the Summer Reading Program.

The OLA Library guides students through all reading levels from preschool through Fifth grade, and provides all students with a place for research and honing their library skills.
