Meeting Opened at 1:00 pm with a prayer led by Sara Jones.

### **President's Report:**

Julie Watts led with introductions and stated that the purpose of Parent Club is to work to benefit our school community; students, teachers and parents through fundraising efforts. Julie motioned to approve the May 16, 2019 minutes, (Meghan/Marissa D. passed unanimously). Julie introduced Principal Gray, EEC Coordinator Leslie Colvin and Brittany Enamorado as the Teacher Rep. She described the parent club committees and opportunities to serve.

### **Principal's Report:**

Shirley leads with a thank you to the parent club, mentioning she really appreciates the collaboration and support with our project based learning initiatives. Shirley is working with the Sheriff's Department on Internet Safety and Emergency Preparedness. She announces that the thrift store has moved to South Higuera and gives a Walk-A-Thon update.

### **Teacher Report:**

Brittany introduces herself as the 4th grade teacher and as a 5th grade parent. She said the teachers are extremely supportive of the start up funds. Brittany talks about assemblies with guest speakers and after school enrichment.

### **Nativity Principal's Report:**

Leslie reports that the STEM money from last year's auction went to a light table for Nativity that rotates between classes. She plans to have ZOO-to-You come to campus and mentions an upcoming gathering with Father Matt.

### **Treasurer's Report:**

Celeste reports on last year's Profit and Loss Statement, stating that over \$100,000 was raised by Parent Club that went back to OMS. She mentions that we have \$2,000 in the bank and that Pizza and Jamba are generating money.

### **Current Business:**

- Stefanie reported that we have made roughly \$600 for the first half of the year on Jamba.
- Trudie reports on sales year over year for pizza and mentions that costs went down and forecasts positive profit.
- Walk-A-Thon (WAT) is a school fundraiser not put on by parent club and is a fundraising effort to bridge the gap between the cost of tuition and the actual cost to educate each student. There will be a separate day for EEC and the goal is \$200 per student, \$60,000 total.
- Erin reports that the second annual Falcon Scramble is Nov. 4th at the Avila Golf Course, as is an event to support Athletics. It is \$150 to golf and \$100 to sponsor a hole.
- MCP Booster Auction is Sept. 28th, benefitting MCP and OMS, 20% of the proceeds go to OMS athletics. MCP's homecoming is October 11th and a Sports Pass is available for entry to all MCP sporting events, \$500 for 4 people.

### **New Business:**

- Julie brings up the idea of a CPK fundraiser for the EEC.
- Trunk-or-Treat may have a new location this year and volunteers are needed.
