



Parents of St. Rose Catholic School students,

For the 2020 - 2021 school year St. Rose Catholic School has contracted the FACTS Management Company to help us manage our **tuition payment program** for our families. All families will be required to use FACTS*.

The FACTS program benefits both the school and our families in numerous ways including:

- FACTS will insure the collection of tuition, consumable fees, and miscellaneous fees thereby reducing problems caused by delinquent tuition payments. As a result, this will allow us to maximize our opportunities to provide the best educational services to your family.
- School administration, office staff, and teachers can spend less time running the business side of the school and spend more time educating the minds and souls of our children.
- Since tuition payments are made automatically by your bank, the program will save the school time and administrative costs associated with periodic billing, accounting and tuition collection.

With FACTS you may have your monthly payments withdrawn from your checking account, savings account, or credit card. You will be able to choose either the 1st, 5th, 15th or the 25th of the month. **St. Rose Catholic School office staff will enter payment information as families provide on your 2020 - 2021 "Saint Rose Catholic School Tuition Contract"** which is found in our registration packet. A **processing fee of 2.85%** will now be passed along through FACTS to any family who wants to use a **credit/debit card** to pay tuition or fees associated with St. Rose Catholic School. **If you want to avoid this additional fee be sure to enter your bank account information.**

***FACTS does charge either a \$20.00 (one or two billings) or \$50.00 (three or more billings) yearly fee per family based upon how many times FACTS bills families.**

Please note: If you already have a FACTS account set-up, your payment plan preferences have been automatically rolled over into the 2020-2021 school year, provided you do not have any outstanding late fees. If you would like to change your payment plan preferences for next year, you must contact the school to do so.
