BACKYARD GAMES

Kinder - 8th

If being the master of your next backyard party is your goal, this class is for you! Students will practice muscle memory and eye-hand coordination through archery, badminton, corn hole, and more!

CARTOONING

Kinder - 8th

This specialized drawing course will teach students how using certain images can create a specific feeling within a cartoon. Students will learn techniques for using simple pictures accompanied by well-chosen words to create meaning for the reader. They will study comic books, comic strips and graphic novels to determine how cartoon communication works.

GROSS SCIENCE

Kinder - 8th

Registration & Regulations

REGISTRATION Students should enroll in classes based on their grade level for the upcoming school year.

There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$50 per student with a maximum of \$100 per family. The non-refundable registration fee must accompany registration forms. Families who pay in full by May 1st will have their registration fee waived.

Pricing is broken up by weeks and is offered full-time or part-time depending on your needs. Please mark whether your child will be:

Full time: 7:00 am - 6:00 pm

Part time PM: 7:00 am - 3:00 pm

Part time AM: 7:00 am - 12:00pm

Please mark the weeks your child will be attending on the registration forms as well as the classes they will be attending. *For Preschool: classes attending registration form will not be needed.

Summer tuition is due each Monday by pickup. No refunds will be given for dropped classes. All schedules are final. There will be a late fee of \$25 if not paid on time.

DROP IN Hourly Rate: \$10

EXTENSION Academic sessions and activities start at 8:00 am and end at 3:00 pm. Students do not need to arrive by 7:00 am, but extension will be open from 7:00 am - 8:00 am and available again from 3:00 pm - 6:00 pm. A late fee of \$2 per minute will be applied after 6:00 pm. Extension may be include in weekly tuition depending on registration.

All students must be signed in and out of Extension daily by an authorized adult. Students who are signed in Extension will be served an afternoon snack daily at 3:30 pm.

ATTENDANCE Students are expected to attend summer school classes daily. If time must be missed, please inform the director or teacher.

SNACK & LUNCH Students should have a snack if they will be on campus during recess (9:30 -10:00). A SNACK SHACK will be available at recess and lunch for students to purchase snacks (prices range from \$0.25 to \$1.00 per item).

Students must have a lunch if they will be on campus during the lunch period (12:00-12:50). Hot Lunch is available on Thursdays with preorder.
