Trimester 3 Progress Reports

Yesterday evening, parents received a Trimester 3 Progress Report via email. This Progress Report may look a bit different than it has in the past due to Distance Learning. Some progress report grades will be uploaded (ie: Reading, Math, Social Studies), and some will be omitted (ie: Penmanship).

We are actively working, under the guidance of the Archdiocese of San Francisco, to come up with a protocol for grading and completing final Trimester 3 report cards in the context of Distance Learning. Teachers have been advised to be flexible with late work and consistent with marking an item missing until it's submitted. Scrip fundraising

The Scrip fundraising year comes to an end next week on April 30th. I have decided to suspend the payoff requirement for families who have not their minimum rebate by April 30th.

This year we set a Scrip fundraising goal of \$48,000 to help offset our school operating expenses. As you can imagine, this fundraising effort – along with other important OLMC fundraising initiatives – is essential to keep tuition as low as possible. Many families chose to participate in the Scrip program and many others chose to opt-out with a one-time donation to the school.

I spent time during holiday to analyze the OLMC Scrip program in advance of the April 30th end date, and based on this analysis, I have decided to suspend payoff requirements. We will send out Scrip rebate balance statements soon after April 30th.

If you are experiencing a financial hardship, we will forgive your minimum Scrip commitment. If – on the other hand – you are in a position to contribute your Scrip commitment, we will welcome your contribution as a donation to OLMC. In addition, we are actively trying to sell our Scrip inventory as we move to an online purchase-only program starting May 1st.
