Fired-up Confirmation Conference

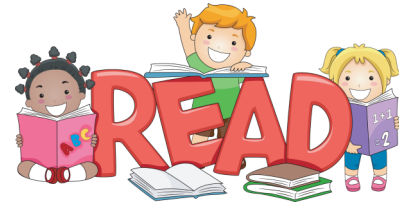
