This is part two of a five part series helping parents to understand the importance of reading to children.

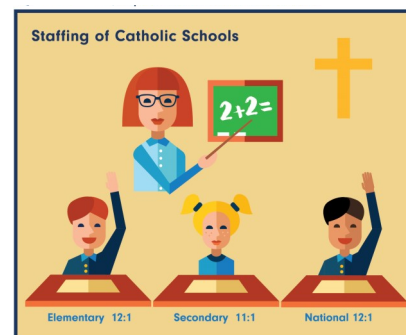
Reading will help your child develop a better mastery of language and speech skills. Children usually learn important language and enunciation (the way a person says words so they are understood) skills throughout their school years. When you read books to your child, you expose them to speech skills early which is an excellent pre-literacy activity.

Numerous studies have shown that early reading

gives kids a better understanding of language fundamentals. *Next week: You will develop a close relationship with your child by reading together.*

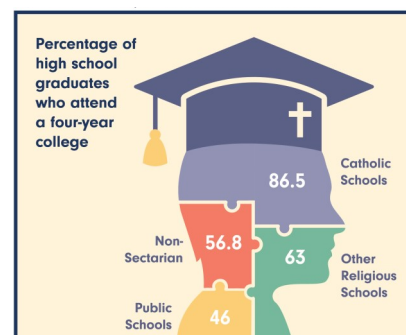
