Activities in the Classroom

TK/K

Students continue to engage classroom routines such as Calendar Time. We are able to count to 100 as a class. Students have been picking out sight words and telling the rest of us something about them.

Kindergarten students have been counting numbers and learning rules to help them, while also using objects to show the numbers.

1st/2nd

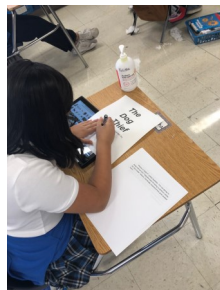
We were able to join the rest of the school as we celebrated Our Lady of the Rosary. Students learned the importance of praying the Rosary. We also finished up the week with a stem activity, building catapults. In grammar, we learned the difference between a statement, question and exclamation sentences.

3rd/4th

Students continued to work on activities to help understanding SLEs. In math 3: students are learning more about Number Sense: Addition and Subtraction. In math 4 students have begun generating and analyzing patterns and continue to practice math facts.

5th/6th

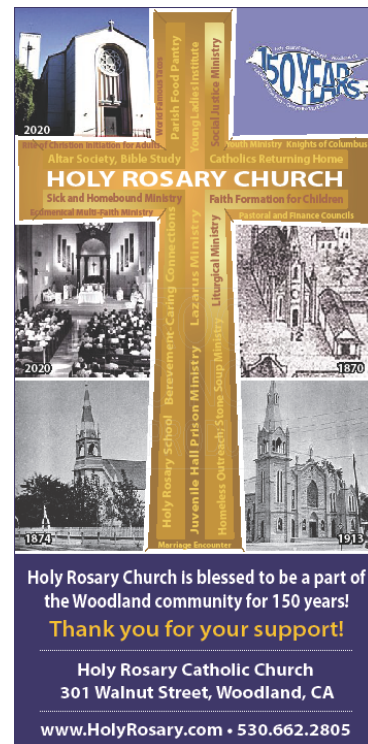
Students worked on finishing up their fictional narratives by turning them into books. They will be reading them to TK/K via zoom. In science, students finished learning about ecosystems and will begin working on a project about a biome to show their understanding of the chapter. Students will also begin a project next week on Native Americans. They will pick a tribe they learned about and write a research report, create a presentation, and make an artifact that the tribe used.



7th/8th

In Religion, students discussed how their conscience

plays a big role in their lives. We also talked about why kids their age feel pressure to fit in or do what their friends do even though they know it isn't the right choice. In ELA students finished writing rough draft letters to a celebrity of their choice. Next week we will work on grammar and structure of the letters. In History, 7th grade finished up our unit on Ancient Rome by discussing the Byzantine Empire, while 8th grade finished up their unit on the 13 Colonies by having to pick one of the colonies they would've wanted to live in and explain why. We are all so excited to finally be back on campus as a class on Tuesday. Great job with distance learning to all 7th and 8th graders, you have made Ms. Ortega so proud!!!
