2021-2022 International Student Tuition Rates and Additional Fees

SCHOOL	APPLICATION FEE (due with required documentation)	ANNUAL TUITION (includes curriculum & tech fee)
High School (9th-12th grade)	\$400 includes placement test	\$10,000*
Middle School (6th-8th grade)	\$400 includes placement test	\$9,700*
Elementary (2nd-5th grade)	\$400 includes placement test	\$9,000*
Kindergarten & 1st grade (Full Day)	\$400 includes placement test	\$8,300*

APPLICATION FEE:

This fee is non-refundable unless there are no openings or the applicant is not accepted. In either case, you are eligible for a \$200 refund. The Application Fee must be included with a completed International Student Application and the required documents to start the review process.

ANNUAL TUITION:

Tuition must be paid by cashier's check, personal check, or wire transfer.

New students: If offered admission to North Hills Christian School the full annual tuition becomes due and payable. A position will be held for two weeks. Should tuition not be received, the position may be released to another student.

Re-enrolling students: There are two payment options:

1. Annual payment: Due by May 15, 2021.
***A \$300 discount applies to this option.**
2. Semi-annual payments:
 First payment is due by May 15, 2021.
 Second payment is due by December 15, 2021.

Please note: *If a student withdraws from North Hills, 10% of the unused tuition is non-refundable.*

DUAL CREDIT COURSES:

Dual Credit is a program in which high school students are able to simultaneously earn both high school AND college-level credit for the *same* course work. Dual credit courses allow the student to choose alternative elective courses. This also allows the student to gain some experience with college instruction and helps the student understand the importance of self-discipline. The professor provides information on what is to be done and when it is due. It then becomes the responsibility of the student to make sure the work is completed and turned in on time.

North Hills Christian School in cooperation with Solano Community College offers dual credit courses for 11th and 12th grade students.

The cost is *per semester* and dependent on the number of credits of the course(s) taken and the cost set by Solano Community College. The range (based on SCC rates for spring, 2021) is \$900 - \$2,400.

The following guidelines are established for enrolling in these courses:

- All book purchases are the responsibility of the student.
- The student is responsible to attend weekly check-in appointments with the NHCS Academic Counselor to provide support for successful course completion.
- The student must provide the NHCS Academic Counselor with student login information.
- Once the course is completed the student is responsible to request that an official transcript be sent to North Hills Christian School.
- Fees for the class must be paid in advance of registration in the class. In the event that a student withdraws from the class, whether due to student choice or instructor drop (student not attending or completing required work), there is NO refund for course fees.

Note: *NHCS is not responsible for monitoring the completion of student work and cannot intervene on the student's behalf with any Solano Community College professor.*
