Student placement takes place only after a completed application and/or enrollment packet is accepted.

Please enroll early. Classes are filled based on a first-come, first-served basis.

RETURNING STUDENT RE-ENROLLMENT DATES/FEES:
\$150 for Early Enrollment submitted by March 1, 2023 (before 9 PM)
\$325 for Regular Enrollment submitted between March 2 and June 9, 2023 (before 9 PM)
\$425 for Late Enrollment submitted after June 9, 2023

NEW STUDENTS - Complete and submit the online application with the \$150 Application Fee (payable via credit or debit card). Your child will be scheduled for a diagnostic test and a parent/child interview. Upon acceptance, access to the online enrollment packet will be emailed for completion. Application fees are non-refundable. If there are no openings or the applicant is not eligible for enrollment, you may receive a refund, less the \$75 diagnostic testing fee.

NEW & RETURNING STUDENTS - The online enrollment packet and enrollment fee must be submitted <u>before</u> enrollment is complete. Enrollment fees are non-refundable after Friday, June 9, 2023. Other Expenses and Information:

- Students will incur additional costs associated with attending NHCS such as uniform costs, dual credit costs, elective/lab fees, and other optional expenses such as school photos, field trips, after school activities, sports, drama/music productions, student activities, etc.
- Students are enrolled for the entire school year at the annual program cost listed above. All monthly tuition payments are processed by automatic deduction through FACTS Payment Plan and Billing. In-house prepayments of any amount will be accepted to lower your monthly payment.
- A \$30.00 late fee is assessed by FACTS for all payments not paid by the due date. Additional costs may be added by North Hills as well as charges by your banking/institution.

New Student Required Documents & Admittance Criteria (Documents must be uploaded or delivered to the school office before enrollment is considered complete.)

ALL GRADES

- Birth Certificate copy (K applicants must be 5 years old by **Oct. 1**)
- Immunization Record (see notes below)
- Recent physical signed by their doctor
- Current Report card (2nd-9th grade) or transcript (10th-12th grade)
- No previous suspensions or expulsions
- Court-ordered Custodial Agreement (if applicable)

6th-12th GRADE ONLY

- Two contact names and email addresses for Letters of Recommendation from an educator and character reference
- GPA of 2.0 minimum, "C" or better

ALL STUDENTS IMMUNIZATION / PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

KINDERGARTEN - State requires that all children entering Kindergarten must have four Polio, five DPT, two MMR (either on or <u>after</u> the child's first birthday), three Hepatitis B, and a Varicella (Chicken Pox) vaccine.

7th GRADE - State requires all children entering 7th grade to have one dose of Tdap on or after the seventh birthday.

PLEASE NOTE: All required shots/physicals must be completed and an up-to-date copy of the immunization record/ physical must be on file by the student's first day of school.

DISCOUNT & FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

The BASIC Fund

K-8th grade students *enrolling in private school for the first time* may apply for need-based scholarships with BASIC Fund (www.basicfund.org). Application period is January through mid-March on a first come, first served basis.

Maximum annual scholarship is \$2,500.

Outside Agencies: NHCS accepts a variety of scholarship payments from outside agencies. Please check with your church, employer, or other Bay Area community agencies for scholarship availability for your child.

REFERRAL INCENTIVE: Families currently enrolled at NHCS and NHCP are eligible for a referral credit by referring a brand new family to NHCS or NHCP.

- Credits are one per new family referral; \$250 for a Preschool family or \$500 for a K-12th grade family.
- The referring family name must be listed on the newly enrolled student application.
- Both the referring and new families' children must be enrolled for four months before the referring family can receive the referral incentive as a credit on their FACTS account.
- If the newly enrolled family has multiple children in preschool and K-12, then the higher earned incentive will be applied.

MULTI-CHILD DISCOUNT: Discounts are available to families with more than one child living in the same household as the financially responsible guardian. Multi-child discounts are applied to students in K-12th grade: Second child \$300 discount; Third child \$600 discount; Fourth child \$900 discount; Fifth child 100% discount. Inquire with the Business Office for preschool sibling discounts.

PRE-PAID DISCOUNT: A 3% tuition discount is offered to families who prepay their annual tuition by cash or check received in the Business Office before the end of the business day on Tuesday, August 1, 2023.

PASTORAL DISCOUNTS: Full-time Senior or Associate Pastors may qualify for a 25% tuition discount for their child provided they are the financially responsible guardian and the child is living in their home. Contact the Business Office for an application. Applications for pastoral discounts are required annually.

North Hills Need-Based Gifts for K-12: FACTS Grant and Aid provides a financial need assessment for families who apply. Applications for tuition assistance are required annually. Apply online at FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment or through your existing FACTS account. Only students who have completed the school enrollment and the Grant and Aid Assessment will be considered for Financial Aid. FACTS charges a non-refundable fee per family for this service and you are asked to upload recent W-2 and 1040 tax forms. Award amounts may be impacted by the timeliness of application, fulfillment of prior years' obligations, and the number of financially qualifying families sharing available funds. Applying for financial aid does not guarantee eligibility for assistance and eligibility does not guarantee that financial aid will be available. Families foreseeing a financial need should prayerfully explore all possible sources of alternate funding. Completed assessments will be reviewed based upon dates of verified submission. Late applicants may be considered as funds are available. As a general rule, the maximum award for first-time NHCS qualified applicants is not more than 20% of the annual tuition. Following years are subject to a reduced maximum.

Tuition discounts are non-cumulative. Families are awarded the highest discount for which they qualify.
