Academics

NHCS provides assessment of student achievement for K-12th grade in a variety of ways. All students are tested quarterly through the Renaissance Learning program, STAR reading. This digital test delivers achievement data about student reading growth. Teachers monitor results and adjust instruction as needed to meet the needs of students. Another assessment that is used school-wide is called MAP (Measures of Appropriate Progress). This adaptive, normed test is administered to all students, two times each school year. Again, the results note student progress and adjustments teachers can make for instruction to support student achievement.

Our technology plan includes the use of Chromebooks and utilizes Google emails and Google classroom for instructional support and to enhance the educational program. Elementary students are assigned a Chromebook to use at school. Middle/High school students are assigned a Chromebook to use at school and at home.

NHCS provides the opportunity for our 11th and 12th grade students to take Dual Credit Courses. These courses are provided at college level in cooperation with the California system of colleges. Students can earn high school AND COLLEGE CREDIT at the same time. The Dual Credit Courses allow for greater individualization of student interest and instruction.
