Volunteer Hours for the Harvest Festival

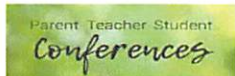
Please remember to record all volunteer hours in the red binder in the front office by **Friday, Oct. 8th by 3:30pm**. No late log in will be accepted.
