Pacific Coast Academy Students Are:

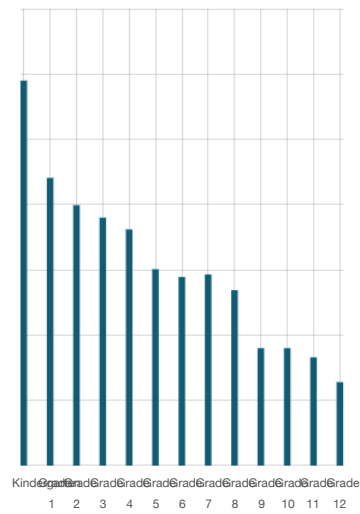
- Navigators of the Digital World - Navigators of the digital world who are proficient in the use of technology, media, and online resources.
