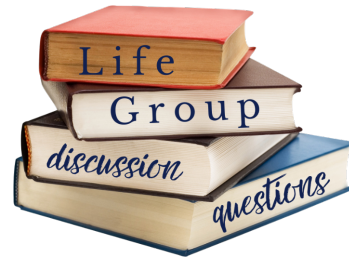


OPENING DISCUSSION

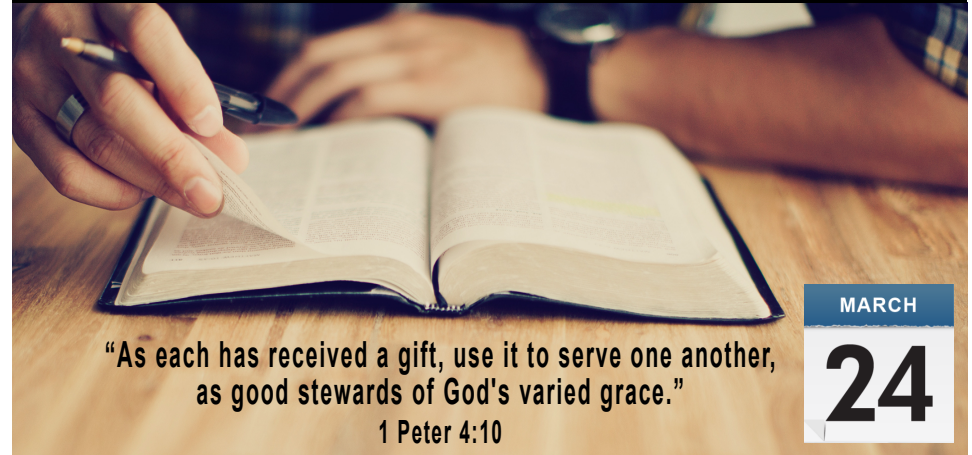
