## Academic

Letters:

- i says "i" as in inchworm
- u says "u" as in umbrella

Writing:

This week our students are learning to write their names correctly (begin with a capital letter, and the rest of the letters are lowercase). They are also writing the letter i.

Math:

- counting 1-10
- number concepts 1-3

## Physical


We are busy coloring! We are learning how to hold a crayon correctly and doing our best to color inside the lines.
