Our kids will be learning all about opposites! For example, they will learn about the difference between full and empty, asleep or awake, and wet versus dry. During this time, the kids must focus to completely understand how to connect these words to actions that occur in their day-to-day lives. By fully comprehending this information, the kids will be able to use these words properly if they accidentally spill a drink and their desk becomes wet or communicate to their teacher when their cup is empty and if they want more water.

Physical

The kids love it when they have the opportunity to work with playdough. This helps them to really focus on their fine motor skills while using the rolling pin or cutting something out with scissors. The kids are able to express their imagination by creating whatever they want.
