Social/Emotional

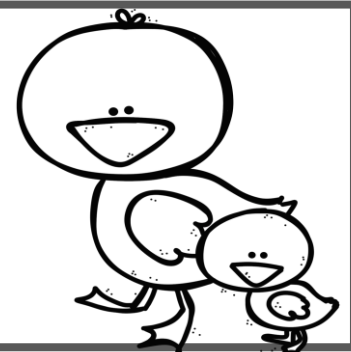
