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## Academic

Letters:

- i says "i" as in inchworm
- u says "u" as in umbrella

Writing:

This week our students are learning to write their names correctly (begin with a capital letter, and the rest of the letters are lowercase). They are also writing the letter i.

Math:

- counting 1-10
- number concepts 1-3

In our Bible lessons, we are learning that God wrote the Bible and that every word in it is true. He also created the world. We have already started learning our first Bible memory verse:

"In the beginning, God created the heaven and the earth." Genesis 1:1

Students are learning:


- to sit quietly

## Academic

We are excited to get this school year started! This week, our focus will be on shapes and colors, as well as learning school routines and making new friends.
