Lexia English too repetitive and can be frustrating: Lexia English only offered to newcomers. Lexia Powerup, Lexia Core 5 Less time online- they seem to be online a lot: ELPAC Workbooks for students, possible bilingual books Classes didn't seem aligned with ELPAC test: <u>ELPAC Task types</u> used to drive instruction in classes- <u>scope and sequence</u> aligned with ELD standards Student felt overwhelmed by the ELPAC- seemed unfamiliar: ELPAC Interim Exams
