New Business

EL ELPAC Levels- ARTEL, LTEL and EL. 37% of students with a score of 3 on ELPAC, close to passing, 10 LTEL Students

ELPI @ 44% 22/23 school year up 31% for 21/22 school year

30% RFEP students, 35 students last year

10.34% EL students passed ELA CAASPP versus 51% schoolwide, 13.33% EL students passed Math CAASPP versus 39% schoolwide. Discussion of what we can do to support students, maybe in person testing for more focus, math vocabulary from ELlevation math

Review of ELD online programs and live class offerings for EL students. Reminder of designated 30 minutes per day of D-ELD. Lexia incentives. ELD website was shared.

SORA Digital Library available to students with translation in 9 languages. Importance of reading daily, and benefits of reading in primary language.

Learning Ally- Give to all EL students, great way to hear correct pronunciation of words in English and support vocabulary development

ELlevation Math- Program to support students with Math vocabulary.

Parent opportunities for support including liaison Maria Ramirez to support in English and Spanish with navigating Cabrillo, parent workshops in English and Spanish, Parent Square and Parent Language translation, and LCAP advisory meetings, Parent English classes. Inviting spokesperson from South Coast Literacy Council to learn about free English classes

Reclassification criteria reviewed and addition of ELPAC chats and goal setting with EL students to focus on skills to increase student achievement on the ELPAC

ELPAC Chat sign up was shared as a way to encourage goal setting, Interim ELPAC offered in October and November.

Discussion of activities and supports were talked about including field trips for students in grades 6-12 that are in the live ELD classes, parents also would like to do service projects together including a clean up, working with homeless or visiting the elderly. Parent expressed interest in English language classes
