Dear SPM School Families,



Several families assist us through charitable giving and matching funds programs from their employers. Our school has memorial cards to remember family or friends. We also have scholarship programs established to assist our school families for which donations can be made in someone's name or memory. FACTS ~ Tuition

All school families are required to open an account with "FACTS" Tuition Management. This company handles all tuition payments on the plan you choose through their website. The first tuition payments for families on the twelve-month plan were due in June. The first payment for those paying over ten months is due in August. All fees are also due at this time. The office must be informed in writing and approve any changes to your contract. You are responsible for all late fees that FACTS may apply.

Financial Aid 2025-2026

The BASIC Fund Grant Application - Tuition Assistance Apply Mid January: The BASIC Fund is a privately funded program dedicated to broadening the educational opportunities for children by helping families afford the cost of tuition at private schools. The BASIC Fund offers scholarships to students entering Preschool through eighth grades. Grant amounts are based on household size and income. For tuition assistance from The BASIC Fund your family must meet their eligibility guidelines. If your child is currently in Preschool/PreK they are also eligible as a "new" student. Applications for The BASIC Fund will be available through our school office and online at www.basicfund.org. Funds are awarded on a first come, first served basis starting Mid Jan until the deadline in March 2025. Applications received after the deadline will be put on a waiting list. BASIC Fund scholarships are renewable through 8th grade as long as all eligibility requirements are met. Renewing families that are applying for a new sibling must complete a new application by the March deadline.

2025-2026 FACE Grants Applications/ Tuition Assistance – Apply Now Through FACTS - FACE (Family Aid Catholic Education) grant applications for the 2025-2026 school year are available to families whose children are enrolled in our school (grades K-8). To be considered for FACE tuition assistance, a third-party processing service, FACTS (Grant & Aid Application), will rank families. The link to apply through FACTS is https://online.factsmgt.com/ga/aid/ inst/4KX6G. FACE applications (through FACTS) are only available online. If you need tuition assistance and your child will attend SPM School next year, you need to apply for Financial aid now through FACTS there are no exceptions. The deadline for the FACE Grant is March 31st. Please note that FACTS is the third-party Financial Aid Processing Service.
