FACTS ~ Tuition & Incidental Billing


All school families are required to open an account with "FACTS" Tuition Management. This company handles all tuition payments on the plan you choose through their website. The first tuition payments for families on the twelve-month plan were due in June. The first payment for those paying over ten months is due in August. All fees are also due at this time. The office must be informed in writing and approve any changes to your contract. You are responsible for all late fees that FACTS may apply.

Parent Participation Hours

Families are required to complete a minimum of 25 parent participation hours. This includes 15 hours of service towards the cafeteria lunch program during the dates assigned to your children's grades. Failure to complete the cafeteria hours during your assigned weeks will result in a charge of twenty-five dollars for each hour not completed. The purpose of assigning dates by grade levels is to assure there is sufficient help each date. If you can volunteer additional help beyond your assigned hours please contact the cafeteria room parent listed on the monthly calendar to schedule time.
