

Curriculum Implementation



Dear Preschool Class, Our focus this week was Aviation and Ash Wednesday. We discussed pilots' roles and components of an airplane. We roleplayed pilots and passengers and packed for a trip to continents around the world. Our first activity was finger painting an airplane with their favorite colors. We cut the airplane and pasted it onto blue construction paper, then the children pulled and stretched cotton balls to add clouds to the blue sky. On Ash Wednesday, Mrs. Tomsic came to our playground and asked the children if they would like to receive ashes on their foreheads. She explained to the children that the ashes were a symbol of being Jesus' followers, and the beginning of Lent. In our sensory table we added airplanes and white tissue paper as clouds. Outside, the children played with the new flag-football belts and pretended to be fire (Red Team) and ice (Blue Team). This week they built skills in socialization, science, religion, color recognition, fine motor and gluing.
