

## Curriculum Implementation



Dear Preschool Class, We started our week by reading a short story about Saint Anthony. We followed by making a replica of a stained glass window with his image. We explained to the children how stained glass windows often tell stories from the Bible or about saints in our churches. In this project the children built fine motor, learned color recognition, math, and religion. Mrs. Tomsic came to our classroom to teach about All Saints & All Souls Day. A day in which "we celebrate holy people who pray a lot and live in heaven with God." In our sensory area we had skeleton bones for children to connect or to hide in tissue paper. Finally, we ended our Halloween curriculum by learning how our bones are connected and how they protect organs like the heart.
