Curriculum Implementation



Dear Preschool Class.

Our activities this week were centered on the cultures of Ghana, Africa. The children listened to a story called Anansi The Spider, a folk tale from the Ashanti Empire, in modern day Ghana. Then we created our own Anansi spiders. The children colored Ghanan flags, they strung beads in a Ghanan flag pattern and we discussed which animals live in Ghana. In these activities the children learned math by counting and connecting how many pieces they needed for their beaded bracelets. They leaned social science, fine motor, colors, and cultural appreciation. We ended the week with our multicultural celebration with families' traditional foods and sharing of cultural dress. For circle time Mrs. Martin played a hand drum called a tubano and they enjoyed watching a short video about children who live and go to school in Ghana. - Mrs. Barajas
