Curriculum Implementation



Dear Preschool Class, This week's activities were centered the Lifecycle of a Plant. The children planted a bean seed. We discussed the bean's texture and color and the needs of a plant (sun light, water, and soil). They will continue learning observational & investigative skills, language and socialization skills as they observe changes in their seed. They strengthened their gross motor and hand-eye coordination when scooping and pouring potting soil that needed to be delivered into a big pot by our gardening area. Then they helped plant a fully grown tomato, bell pepper, and mint plants. At Circle Time they listened to stories like The Grouchy Ladybug by Eric Carle, One Bean by Anne Rockwell, and Growing Vegetable Soup by Lois Ehlert. They role played being seeds and growing into a big plant with Mrs. Clark and for art they made a spring flower collage.
