Our focus this week was Spring and Parts of a Flower. The children continue to develop fine & gross motor skills when scooping and pouring potting soil. They are learning observational & investigative skills when digging for worms and roly polies in our playground. We provided a coloring page about parts of a flower and discussed how the roots absorb water and nutrients from the soil. They listened to a story named The Tiny Seed by Eric Carle and some children were so fascinated that they illustrated their own story of the tiny seed. Another child found a seed in her apple and referred to the story. We will continue with hands-on learning opportunities about planting and gardening. 





