Dear Queen of All Saints School Families,

Guess what?! Our auction is almost sold out, and there are only a few hours left to purchase tickets! You have until 9:00 PM tonight to buy on the Greater Giving website. All tables are sold out, but there are still a few individual seats available.

If you are unable to attend, you can use the same link to donate to our Fund-a-Need. This year's proceeds will support our revamped woodshop (opening next school year) and financial aid. Please feel free to share the link with friends and family who may be interested in supporting our school.

I hope to see everyone at Open House on Sunday. This is another wonderful opportunity to invite friends and family! We will begin with Family Mass at 10:30 AM, followed by classroom visits. You'll be able to see what your child has been working on, visit next year's classroom, and help us welcome new families who are touring. Students in full uniform for Mass and the Open House will earn a free dress pass for a future date.

Open House also kicks off Catholic Schools Week. On Friday, we will host our annual CSW Family Picnic. The gates will open at 11:30 AM. Students will be lined up on the red porch, and we will call them by class. When your youngest child's class is called, you may go pick them up. More details will be in next week's Scoop.

Students whose families are unable to attend are welcome to:

- join another family who can "adopt" them for the day (please let your child's teacher know ahead of time), or
- eat lunch in the classroom with their teacher, who will make it a special event.

For the picnic, please bring lunch for your family. This is anything from a favorite takeout order to classic picnic-style goodies. You are welcome to bring your own setup, including a blanket if you'd like to sit on the grass (maybe an extra few to lay on top of you, as I think it's forecasted to be dry but cold!). We will also have tables available, and classrooms will be open as well.

The Book Fair will be open before the picnic until 11:30 AM, and again after lunch starting at 12:30 PM. After lunch, students may return to their classrooms unless you choose to take them home. You are welcome to sign your child(ren) out from their classroom (as we did for the Christmas show), or you may send them back to class and pick them up at 3:00 PM for regular dismissal. The Family Picnic event officially ends at 1:30 PM. I hope to see you there!!



Fishing for People - Telling others about Jesus (Matthew 4:18-23)

Our Bible lesson today has something to do with fishing. One day, Jesus was walking along the seashore when he saw two brothers named Peter and Andrew. Jesus knew they made their living by fishing, so He called out to them, "Follow me, and I will show you how to fish for people!" Do you know what they did? They laid down their fishing nets and followed Jesus.

Jesus wants you and me to fish for people, too. That means that Jesus wants us to tell others about what He has done for us and what He wants to do for them. Fishing for

people is a lot like fishing for fish.

First, we need to be properly equipped. We need to know what the Bible teaches and learn how to share it with others.

Next, we go out where the people are and tell them about Jesus.

Finally, we must be patient.

If we will do these things, we can really become fishers of people like Jesus wants us to be. If you think there is a great feeling of excitement in catching a fish, just imagine how exciting it must be to bring someone to Jesus!

Dear Jesus, help us become fishers of people. Help us tell others what You have done for us and what you want to do for them. In Jesus' name, amen.

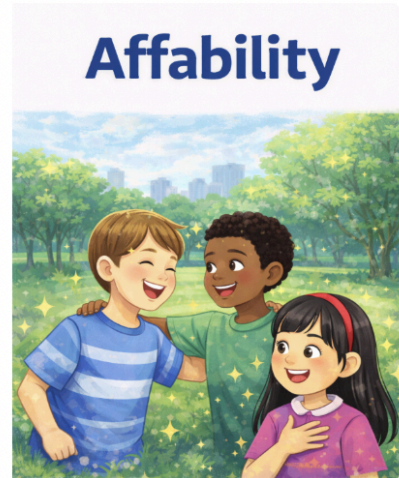
