

**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT  
A CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE  
FOR GRANITE MOUNTAIN CHARTER SCHOOL**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Granite Mountain Charter School (the “School”), a California nonprofit public benefit corporation operating a charter school with the same name, tentatively approved a Conflict of Interest Code (“Code”) pursuant to Government Code section 87300 at its meeting on November 23, 2019, and intends to finally adopt the Code. This Code supersedes all prior drafts previously presented to the School’s governing board. Pursuant to Government Code Sections 87200 and 87302, the Code will designate public officials, employees, and consultants of the School who make governmental decisions and who, therefore, must disclose certain investments, interests in real property, sources of income, and business positions, and may disqualify themselves from making or participating in the making of governmental decisions affecting those interests.

A public comment period has been established commencing on December 2, 2019, and terminating on January 16, 2020 (a 45-day period). Any interested person may present written comments concerning the proposed Code no later than the last day of the public comment period, January 16, 2020, to the School’s representative at the address listed below. No public hearing on this matter will be held unless any interested person or his or her representative requests a public hearing no later than 15 days prior to the close of the written comment period.
