

## **ANNUAL AUCTION FAQs**

**Q: *How many hours can I receive for my confirmed business donation(s)?***

A: For every submitted business donation valued at \$60 or more, you will receive 3 service hours credited toward your auction hour obligation.

**Q: *How do I sign up to help with the auction?***

A: If you are looking to volunteer your time for the school auction you must attend the "All-Volunteer Auction Meetings" to sign up for specific jobs. Due to limited workspace and volunteer opportunities, only volunteers who have previously signed up to work the evening of the auction will be needed at the event.

**Q: *What if my donated item wasn't purchased by me and I don't have a receipt? (i.e. un-used gift card, or regifted item)***

A: Only new items with a verified value will be accepted. You will receive credit based on the verified value of your item(s).

**Q: *Where do I log my volunteer hours for the auction?***

A: You can log your volunteer hours for the auction in the Auction Binder in the school office. Any additional service hours will be kept in a separate binder. Please ask the office staff for assistance.

**Q: *Will there be child care on the night of the auction?***

A: For the safety of our students and families, Queen of All Saints does not offer child care for this event. We strongly encourage our families to find alternative childcare for this adult-only event.

**Q: *Do auction donations count toward my fundraising obligation?***

A: Auction donations do not count toward your family fundraising obligation. Families will be credited one service hour for every \$20 worth of donations (ex. A donation valued at \$60 will receive a family service hour credit of 3 hours.) You MUST include a receipt for the donated item.

**Q: *Is there an opportunity to complete auction service hours over the Summer?***

A: Yes! We have opportunities that come up over the Summer. See Sign-Up Genius for more items requested. (<https://www.signupgenius.com/go/4090f49aea922a0fa7-auction1>) Note, certain items are due at the Uniform Sale.

**Q: *Where can I locate all auction information?***

**Q: *If I sign up to help and can no longer keep my commitment, is there a penalty?***

A: As with all events planned for our school, executing the event is dependent on the volunteers that make it happen. If you have signed up to help and can no longer fulfill your commitment, you have the option of finding a replacement within 72 hours prior to the event, or being assessed a \$75 charge for each missed session you signed up for. PACE and ASB recognize that emergencies may arise. In the case of an emergency, volunteers should contact the event coordinator directly.
