We learned the song <u>"If You're Feeling and You Know It"</u> which gave the children a fun way to explore the different ways we might feel. We read and colored a book about how to deal with <u>being frustrated</u>. On one day we even incorporated our <u>shape of the day</u>, an octagon, with our feelings discussion. We talked to the children about how we can tell people to STOP when we don't like something they are doing to us, and how we can respect others words and bodies when they tell us to stop, all before coloring an <u>octagon shaped stop sign</u> and writing/tracing the letters for stop on it. We continued to incorporate shapes and colors into our day when we played, "Little Mouse" hiding him and asking "Are you in the color & shape house?".
