Dear Queen of All Saints School Families,

Thank you to our family volunteers who did an amazing job clearing out all of the furniture and boxes full of books and materials from the four large storage pods. They worked tirelessly over a span of several days to help get the school and classrooms back together now that the construction is just about finished. The construction crews are awaiting the arrival of the new outdoor water bottle filling stations, the new dishwasher for extended care, and a few other minor items, but the end is near!

With the buildings and classrooms looking so beautiful, we are now adding new flooring in the Kindergarten wing hallway and we are adding new bulletin boards to the Kindergarten and TK classrooms to have a nice space to display student work. Once those projects are completed in the next two weeks, the rooms will be ready for the Self-Guided School Tour of all three buildings on Wednesday, October 28 from 12:00 noon-3:00, and then for classes to resume for our students. Next week's Scoop will provide details of how to conduct the self-guided tour.

We are still looking at Monday, November 2nd as our date to return to in-person instruction. I know that there are many questions as we move closer to that date, including what options will be available for students who will not be returning to on-campus learning. I have attended meetings this past week and will attend one more meeting tomorrow to learn about a viable option that will meet the needs of our at-home learners while also allowing teachers to be fully present for the on-campus students. I will be learning about a HyFlex model that is being used successfully in several dioceses in California. My goals are to provide all of our students, whether on campus or at home a safe space, a quality and engaging student experience, and strong academic programs that are the hallmark of our school.

The teachers will be sending you Zoom invites where I will be present to answer your questions and provide you with the latest information on HyFlex and in-person learning. They will provide you with an opportunity to send in your questions ahead of time so we can use our time efficiently.

I know that you have answered several surveys already this year, but I am requesting that you take two minutes to answer this [Family Learning Choice Survey](#). Knowing that we will be providing a viable at-home learning option and an in-person learning option, I need to know at this time which option your family is seriously considering for your student(s). This will help me finalize our plan and I can move forward in providing you with details for the schedules and learning models. For families who need an afternoon extended care option, thank you for completing the [extended care survey](#). I will do my best to provide this service to you as soon as possible in a way that is safe for the students and staff.

Thank you for your continued support and partnership as we begin to finalize our plans to return to our school campus. I look forward to seeing the students' excitement and joy when they see their new classrooms during the Self-Guide School Tour.

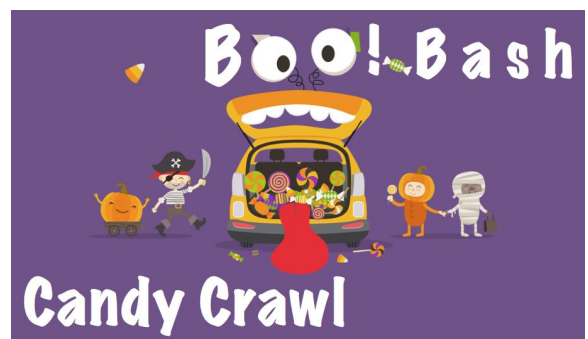
