
Angels Gate Cultural Center provides space for artists to work and to engage community through arts education, exhibitions of contemporary art, and cultural events.






# **Artists-in-Classrooms History**

Artists-in-Classrooms started in the 1990s with teachers and Principals calling AGCC to ask for artists to teach in their classrooms

2013: AIC grew from serving 10 classrooms to 40 classrooms

2013-2018: AIC has grown from 40 classrooms to 135 classrooms each year



#### **AIC Philosophy**

Placing professional artists into public school classrooms

Grounded in California VAPA Standards in four diversified art forms

Twelve weeks of 1-hour lessons

Arts lessons taught with Classroom Teacher participation

Arts Integration opportunities

Creative-thinking, process over product, and fun!
