Last weekend our inveterate math teacher Jenifer Spinale spent three days in Monterey at the Asilomar California State Math Conference. According to Ms. Spinale she attended excellent sessions on geometric modeling, gamefication of math, growth mindset and math and the arts. A few weeks earlier Marguerite Pini attended a conference for principals sponsored by the National Catholic Education Association. Topics included technology, strategic planning, development of effective advisory boards, and effective teacher observation. Both Ms. Spinale and Ms. Pini are already putting into practice some of what they learned at their conferences.

In addition, students from Kindergarten to eighth grade honed their math skills as they worked in family groups to solve hundreds of math problems. Way to go, Vikings!

As we turn up the heat in our cars, homes and school we are reminded of our brothers and sisters who have no protection from these icy conditions. On the same day in another venue, kindergartners sat spellbound during ODC productions of *The Velveteen Rabbit*.

Each year Davies Symphony Hall is transformed into a Christmas wonderland. Christmas trees adorn the rotunda, each of them decorated by a different organization. The St. Vincent de Paul tree shimmers with decorations of tin boats and fishes, following an America's Cup theme. Our art students, under the tutelage of Ms. Vicki Bamsey, created the ornaments. Thank you to both students and teacher!

Don't forget the lovely Christmas program to be held on Wednesday, December 18 at 6:30pm in the Church. This event allows our entire school community to pray together and enjoy the beautiful voices of our children as they sing their Christmas music.
