Dear Parents,

We hosted two wonderful visitors this week. The first was Ms. Ashley Jenks, a guest musician, who spent Monday and Wednesday teaching the children a variety of songs. Your children were enthusiastic participants as they learned an African song called "Siyahamba" and other musical pieces accompanied by hand motions. If you were present at Wednesday's morning assembly you heard their wonderful voices and enthusiastic rendition of "Trading My Sorrows". Look for these to be sung at upcoming liturgies and prayer services.

Our second visitor was Mr. Bret Allen, associate superintendent of Catholic Schools for the Archdiocese of San Francisco. On Tuesday, he attended morning assembly, visited classes, met with Fr. Ken and ended his day speaking with the assembled faculty. Mr. Allen praised our teachers for their dedication and commitment and commented that the students he spoke with "loved their school".

Last Tuesday Nancy Barrett, K.C. McCabe, Katie Nejasmich, Marguerite Pini, Jenifer Spinale and Paul Watters spent a lovely day in Tiburon. No, they weren't enjoying the beautiful weather; they were attending an iPad workshop at St. Hilary's, an Apple Distinguished School. Each person had the opportunity to investigate the latest iPad applications, see classroom demonstrations and talk to teachers and students. They discovered that the infusion of technology in the classroom offers endless possibilities to enhance learning for all students. They returned to St. Vincent de Paul eager to share their experiences with other faculty.

At yesterday's faculty meeting each teacher demonstrated an iPad application designed to support teaching and learning. This proved a good opportunity for faculty members to see the breadth of educational applications available to them. Our goal is to continue to utilize the iPad as an instructional tool so we might reach the ultimate goal of using the devices in our classrooms.

The safety of your children is our first priority. Last year Matt Devine began designing an emergency plan for our school. That plan is now completed and we have begun to implement the recommendations Mr. Devine made. We are purchasing new emergency backpacks for each classroom that contain more varied supplies than the old backpacks. We have purchased walkietalkies as one communication system. These will be used every day at recess and lunch and in case of any emergency. Bids have been submitted for a new phone system which will allow better communication between individual classrooms and the main office and will help support our efforts in an emergency situation. Finally, we are seeking bids for a pedestrian gate with a camera which will provide the only access point to the school grounds. This addition will help secure our campus.

Field trips continue with the fourth grade walking to the Presidio on Friday. They will learn about the science of archaeology. They may come back to school with dirty hands, but it will be better than the fish smell the third graders brought back from their experiment with the squid and its black ink!

It is my desire that this new board will be involved in all aspects of our school, especially development, finance, facilities, outreach, strategic planning and goal setting.



We're also building classroom libraries through the fair. You can purchase any book on a teacher's posted "Classroom Wish List" and donate it to the classroom to enrich students for years to come.




