

SACRED HEART SCHOOL DRESS CODE

All students are required to wear the Sacred Heart School uniform from the first day of school until the last week of school. All students must wear dress uniform to school Masses (usually every Wednesday) and at the direction of the principal. **Items with an asterisk (*) must be purchased from Dennis Uniforms or obtained in the uniform closet.**

Student Uniform - Boys

- Pants:** Grades TK-6: Navy blue pants
- Shorts:** Grades TK-6: Navy blue shorts
- Shirt:** Grades TK-6: White dress shirt with pointed collar (short or long sleeve) with white buttons and no color piping in the collar
- OR**
- Gray or White polo shirt (short or long sleeve) with no color piping in the collar
- Shirt:** Grades 7-8: Navy blue polo with khaki pants/shorts or white polo with navy blue pants/shorts.
- NO TURTLENECK SHIRTS ARE ALLOWED.
- Sweater:** Grades TK-8: Navy blue V-neck cardigan
- No other sweaters are allowed in the classroom.
- Vest:** Grades TK-8: Navy blue V-neck sweater vest
- Sweatshirt:** Grades TK-6: Navy blue SHS sweatshirt when worn over a uniform shirt (They can be purchased through Dennis Uniforms or ordered through the school each fall.)
- OR**
- Navy blue, white, or grey SHS spirit sweatshirt when worn over a uniform shirt (They can be purchased through the school.)
- No other sweatshirts will be allowed in the classroom.
- Navy blue SHS sweatshirt when worn over a uniform shirt (They can be purchased through Dennis Uniforms or ordered through the school each fall.)
- OR**
- Navy blue, white, or grey SHS spirit sweatshirt when worn over a uniform shirt (They can be purchased through the school.)
- OR**
- Hooded SHS class sweatshirt, usually navy and purchased through the school. Order forms to be sent home in September.
- No other sweatshirts will be allowed in the classroom.
- Jacket:** Grades TK-6: *SHS Polartec Jacket

Boys Dress Uniform:

Grades TK-6: White dress shirt tucked into belted uniform long pants.
Uniform sweatshirts and cardigans are acceptable on dress uniform days. (no tying around the waist)

Nice Free Dress:

Special events (i.e., Elks Student of the Month, some field trips, etc.) require Nice Free Dress, which consists of a collared shirt and slacks for ALL boys. ABSOLUTELY NO BLUE JEANS. Dress shoes for boys are encouraged, as are ties for boys.

GENERAL DRESS CODE and UNIFORM REGULATIONS

- All clothing should be marked clearly with student first and last name
- Uniform items need to be size-appropriate and may not be modified in any way (e.g., purchasing smaller sizes than are appropriate or hemming skirts, etc.).
- No distracting shoes such as with lights, buzzers, or skating, etc.
- Sandals and open-toed shoes are never allowed.
- Only school uniform sweatshirts may be worn.
- Outer coats may be worn over the uniform while outside, but not in the classroom (sweaters only).
- No other clothing is allowed including Scout uniforms or Little Flower uniforms.
- Students must call home for a change of clothes if out of uniform.
- If circumstances prevent a student from coming to school in uniform, a note must be sent to the teacher. The substitute uniform should be as similar to the uniform as possible.
- NO HATS
- NO TATTOOS, permanent or washable
- No fake nails, nail polish, or French manicures.
- A clean, well-groomed appearance is required for students. Students sent to school without attention to cleanliness, uniform, or neatness may be sent home to be properly prepared for school.
- Hairstyles are to be simple, clean, and neat. Hair must be its natural color with no highlights, no fads, distinct layers, or distracting hairstyles.
- Boys' hair must be out of the eyes, above the ears, and off the collar.
- Boys must be clean shaven (when applicable).
- The only acceptable forms of jewelry that may be worn at any time include a wristwatch (for boys or girls), one pair of matching stud earrings for girls only (to be worn one in each earlobe only), a holy medal, cross, or crucifix on a chain, a scapular that is worn inside the shirt or blouse (for boys or girls), or a medical alert necklace and/or bracelet when necessary (no other bracelets may be worn).

UNIFORM HOLIDAYS

On certain days, the principal may call a uniform holiday. On these occasions, students need to be dressed in a manner consistent with modesty and follow any guidelines laid out by the principal for the occasion. Students in grades K – 6 may have a uniform holiday on their birthdays (must be approved by the teacher).

FREE DRESS/ SPIRIT DAY

- Modesty and simplicity are guiding principles for free dress.
- No extreme fads
- Jeans in good repair (with no holes, intentional or otherwise) will be acceptable for casual “free dress” (not on “dress up” days or addressing the student body at Mass).
- Pants of any kind must fit appropriately (i.e. not skin tight, no spandex and no skinny jeans).
- Pants should be worn at the waist (no sagging).
- No midriff shirts, loose baggy trousers, cutoffs, see-through shirts, or bike shorts are allowed.
- Objectionable clothing displaying images (e.g., alcohol, tobacco, drugs, controversial rock groups, or themes) are not allowed.
- Flat soled shoes only; NO BOOTS.
- Sandals are not allowed.
- Socks must be worn at all times.
- If there is doubt as to what is appropriate, a plain T-shirt (w/ sleeves) and jeans in good repair should be acceptable.
