Clothing from Dennis Uniform lasts longer than clothing purchased at WMart etc.

Land's End also carries the school jumper, look for the Marymount plaid.

Student Uniform Code - Girls

Jumper: Grades1-4: Uniform plaid jumper *

It is suggested that shorts be worn under jumpers; they may not hang lower than the jumper.

Jumpers may not be shorter than 3" above mid-knee.

Skirt: Grades 5th & 6th only: Uniform plaid skirt *

It is suggested that shorts may be worn under skirts; they may not hang lower than the skirt. Skirts may not be shorter than 3" above mid-knee.

Pants: Grades TK-6: Navy blue pants

Shorts: Grades TK-6: Navy blue shorts

Skorts: Grades TK-6: Navy skirt with tabs

Blouse: Grades TK-6: White Peter Pan collared (aka rounded collar) blouse with jumper.

White or gray polo shirt (short or long sleeve) with white buttons and no color piping on the collar. May be worn with pants, shorts, skorts, and skirts.

NO TURTLENECK SHIRTS ARE ALLOWED.

Sweater: Grades TK-6: Navy blue V-neck cardigan

No other sweaters are allowed in the classroom.

Vest: Grades TK-6: Navy blue V-neck sweater vest

Sweatshirt: Grades TK-6: Navy blue SHS sweatshirt when worn over a uniform shirt
(They can be purchased through Dennis Uniforms or ordered through the school each fall.)

OR

Navy blue, white, or grey SHS spirit sweatshirt when worn over a uniform shirt. (They can be purchased through the school. Order forms will be sent home on the first day of school)

Hooded SHS sweatshirt

(They can be purchased through the school. Order forms will be sent home on the first day of school)

No other sweatshirts will be allowed in the classroom.

Jacket: Grades TK-6: SHS Polartec Jacket *

Girls Dress Uniform:

Grades TK-6: Jumpers with white Peter Pan collared blouse.

Uniform sweatshirts and cardigans are acceptable on dress uniform days.

Grades TK-6: Skirt with white button-down oxford blouse (short or long sleeve) worn neatly tucked into skirt

Uniform sweatshirts and cardigans are acceptable on dress uniform days.

(No tying around waist)

Student Uniform Code - Boys and Girls

Socks: Grades TK-6:

SOLID WHITE, above the shoe - can be knee or crew socks. Socks must be worn at all times. No patterns, stripes, or insignias. Girls may wear white, black, or navy blue opaque solid-color tights. Ankle length leggings or leg warmers are allowed, but must be black or blue. No capris are allowed.

Shoes: Grades TK-8:

Students have a choice of either tennis shoes with minimal markings, or rubber-soled oxfords, or Mary Janes. No light-ups are permitted. NO high tops, clogs, sandals, or boots are allowed. During rainy season rain boots may be worn if permission is granted by the principal. This also applies to Free Dress days. When selecting a shoe for school, please keep safety in mind. Every student needs to be able to participate in recess play and P.E. without fear of injury. Do not purchase black-soled shoes that leave marks on the floor.

P.E.: (Tk-6th)

Students wear regular school uniform

Girls must wear shorts underneath skirts

Must wear athletic shoes with laces or Velcro (no slip-ons, dress shoes, or Mary Jane's, etc.)

GENERAL DRESS CODE and UNIFORM REGULATIONS

- All clothing should be marked clearly with student first and last name
- Uniform items need to be size-appropriate and may not be modified in any way (e.g., purchasing smaller sizes than are appropriate or hemming skirts, etc.).
- No distracting shoes such as with lights, buzzers, or skating, etc.
- Sandals and open-toed shoes are never allowed.
- Only school uniform sweatshirts may be worn.
- Outer coats may be worn over the uniform while outside, but not in the classroom (sweaters only).
- No other clothing is allowed including Scout uniforms or Little Flower uniforms.
- Students must call home for a change of clothes if out of uniform.
- If circumstances prevent a student from coming to school in uniform, a note must be sent to the teacher. The substitute uniform should be as similar to the uniform as possible.
- NO HATS
- NO TATTOOS, permanent or washable
- No fake nails, nail polish, or French manicures.
- A clean, well-groomed appearance is required for students. Students sent to school without attention to cleanliness, uniform, or neatness may be sent home to be properly prepared for school.
- Make-up, lipstick, or colored lip gloss are not permitted for the school day.
- Clear lip balm only is permitted.
- Hairstyles are to be simple, clean, and neat. Hair must be its natural color with no highlights, no fads, distinct layers, or distracting hairstyles.
- Boys' hair must be out of the eyes, above the ears, and off the collar.
- Boys must be clean shaven (when applicable).
- The only acceptable forms of jewelry that may be worn at any time include a wristwatch (for boys or girls), one pair of matching stud earrings for girls only (to be worn one in each earlobe only), a holy medal, cross, or crucifix on a chain, a scapular that is worn inside the shirt or blouse (for boys or girls), or a medical alert necklace and/or bracelet when necessary (no other bracelets may be worn).

UNIFORM HOLIDAYS

On certain days, the principal may call a uniform holiday. On these occasions, students need to be dressed in a manner consistent with modesty and follow any guidelines laid out by the principal for the occasion. Students in grades K – 6 may have a uniform holiday on their birthdays (must be approved by the teacher).

FREE DRESS/ SPIRIT DAY

- Modesty and simplicity are guiding principles for free dress.
- No extreme fads
- Jeans in good repair (with no holes, intentional or otherwise) will be acceptable for casual “free dress” (not on “dress up” days or addressing the student body at Mass).
- Pants of any kind must fit appropriately (i.e. not skin tight, no spandex and no skinny jeans).
- Pants should be worn at the waist (no sagging).
- Halters, tank tops, or spaghetti straps are not allowed.
- No midriff shirts, loose baggy trousers, cutoffs, see-through shirts, or bike shorts are allowed.
- Objectionable clothing displaying images (e.g., alcohol, tobacco, drugs, controversial rock groups, or themes) are not allowed.
- Flat soled shoes only; NO BOOTS.
- Sandals are not allowed.
- Socks must be worn at all times.
- If there is doubt as to what is appropriate, a plain T-shirt (w/ sleeves) and jeans in good repair should be acceptable.
