

St. Anthony School Parents' Club Contract

PARENT INVOLVEMENT POLICY:

Every successful education program depends upon positive action, cooperation, and involvement of the parents or guardians of the children with the school and the parish community. Tuition meets less than half of the actual cost of education. Therefore, it is imperative that all registered families of St. Anthony School be actively involved in the support, service, and fundraising events of the school. All money received from fund raising activities helps to keep our tuition affordable.

Parents' Club dues are \$65.00 per family and payable at the beginning of each school year.

The following represents the point system as defined in the Participation Plan of our Parents' Club Constitution and By-Laws:

1. Each family is required to earn fifty (50) points per semester.
2. Five (5) points will be given for each hour worked on a fundraising activity.
3. Classroom volunteering or driving on field trips does not count towards Parents' Club points.
4. Room mothers who fulfill their duties will receive twenty-five (25) points per semester.
5. Booster Club membership is worth one hundred (100) points and will be distributed as fifty (50) points per semester.
6. All food and drink donations are worth one fourth (1/4) the dollar value in points (1 point = \$4).
7. Parents' Club Officers who fulfill their duties will receive fifty (50) points per semester.
8. Committee Chairs who fulfill their duties will receive one hundred (100) points in the semester their event takes place. Co-Chairs will receive fifty (50) points each. Reports must be turned in to the office before point credits will be given to the chairperson.
9. Sports Coaches will receive one hundred (100) points in the semester they coach.
10. Five (5) points will be given per family for attending a Parents' Club Meeting.
11. Points for fundraising are worth one fourth (1/4) the total dollars turned in (1 point = \$4).
12. All parents are required to participate in the Knights' Gala fundraiser by selling 20 raffle tickets.
13. All parents are required to sell 15 Uncle Buck's Drive Thru Dinner Tickets.
14. **EACH FAMILY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR RECORDING** their hours worked, dollars raised, and donations made. Records will be kept in the school office. Points earned for attendance at Parents' Club meetings, Dinner Auction donations, and Booster Club membership will be submitted by the chairmen of those committees. Written notices will be sent to those incurring a penalty or with lagging points.
15. Families will be fined \$400 at year end for not earning required points; this can be prorated depending on the number of points short of the required amount.
16. **Points are non-transferable, nor carried over to the next school year.**

Parent participation is encouraged in a major fundraiser each semester.
