

St. Anthony School Parents' Club Contract—2020-21 School Year

PARENT INVOLVEMENT POLICY:

Every successful education program depends upon positive action, cooperation, and involvement of the parents or guardians of the children with the school and the parish community. Tuition meets less than half of the actual cost of education. Therefore, it is imperative that all registered families of St. Anthony School be actively involved in the support, service, and fundraising events of the school. All money received from fund raising activities helps to keep our tuition affordable.

Parents' Club dues are \$65.00 per family and due before the first day of school.

The following represents the point system as defined in the Participation Plan of our Parents' Club Constitution and By-Laws:

1. Families are required to complete the following:
 - A. Sell 20 Knights' Gala Raffle Tickets and 2 Knights' Gala Dinner Tickets
 - B. Sell Uncle Buck's Tickets—15 tickets for Fall Fundraiser & 10 tickets for Spring Fundraiser
 - C. Work at least 5 hours at one fundraiser each semester
 - D. Attend minimum of 3 Parents' Club meetings per semester
 - E. In addition to the above, earn 50 points for the year
2. How to earn points:
 - A. Five (5) points will be given for each hour worked on a fundraising activity.
 - B. Five (5) points will be given per family for attending a Parents' Club Meeting.
 - C. Fundraising donations are worth one fourth (1/4) the total dollars turned in (1 point = \$4).
 - D. All food & drink donations are worth one fourth (1/4) the dollar value in points (1 point = \$4).
 - E. ****Classroom volunteering, donations to classrooms, or driving on field trips does not count towards Parents' Club points.**
 - F. Room mothers who fulfill their duties will receive twenty-five (25) points per semester. ****Only 2 room moms per classroom and must be approved by teacher.**
 - G. Parents' Club Officers who fulfill their duties will receive twenty-five (25) points per semester.
 - H. Committee Chairs who fulfill their duties will receive fifty (50) points in the semester their event takes place. Co-Chairs will receive twenty-five (25) points each. Reports must be turned in to Vice-President before point credits will be given to the chairperson.
 - I. Sports Coaches will receive fifty (50) points in the semester they coach.
 - J. Booster Club membership is worth fifty (50) points and will be distributed as twenty-five (25) points per semester.
3. Fall Festival Chairman is head room mom with committee to include all room moms.
4. **EACH FAMILY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR RECORDING** their hours worked, donations made & dollars raised through **Stanthonyknights.Beehively.com**. Points earned for attendance at Parents' Club meetings, Dinner Auction donations, and Booster Club membership will be submitted by the chairmen of those committees.
5. Written notices will be sent to those incurring a penalty or with lagging points.
6. Families will be fined \$400 at year end for not earning required points.
7. **Points are non-transferable, nor carried over to the next school year.**
