Thank you to our parent volunteers who helped the photographer and teachers and made the day run smoothly. If your child missed picture day, there will be a picture make-up day on Wednesday, October 16.

Teachers posted the link for upcoming Parent-Teacher Conferences on their Class Dojo. Conferences are mandatory, with days and times scheduled on a first come, first served basis. Please make sure to visit your child(ren)'s homeroom Class Dojo for the Sign-Up Genius link. If you have yet to connect to your child's Class Dojo, please locate the email that was sent to you to access the link, or contact the classroom teacher for more information. Class Dojo is the main means of communication between the classroom teacher and families, and the main way to keep current with important information and reminders from the school. We have 90% of our families connected to their Class Dojo – we are hoping to have 100% participation by the end of the week. Connect today!

A Marquee Birthday Message form has been created and linked on the school website (qasconcord.org) for ease in requesting a special birthday message for your child. We are excited to have streamlined this process for the many requests and surprise messages.

Lastly, thank you for completing and submitting the various WCEA/WASC accreditation surveys. Your feedback is important for school improvement and the accreditation process. We were able to access an online version of the Catholic Identity survey for your convenience. Paper surveys will also be used in the data collection process. A few questions have been asked about how to answer a couple of the survey questions that may not be readily apparent to our families. In answer to two of the questions that were asked: The school Religion texts are approved by the Bishop and the Staff Development Committee. Grades K-5th use RCL Benziger Be My Disciple, while grades 6-8 use St. Mary's Press Catholic Connections. Classroom teachers receive Catechetical Certification through the Diocese of Oakland by participating in Catechetical inservices at school and during diocesan professional development days. Please feel free to send me an email if you have questions on other parts of the survey. I appreciate the thoughtfulness you have shown in your answers.

Feast Day of St. Michael 9/29 (Catholic Icing)

Catholic families that live the liturgical year at home look forward to celebrating the feast of St. Michael and the Archangels on September 29! Much like the feast days "Christmas" or "Candlemas", the name comes from pushing the main word... Michael... into the word "mass". Henceforth, Michaelmas. Today, I would like to share with you some ideas and activities to celebrate Michaelmas with your kids, but first, I want to share a little bit about this day with you.

Who Are The Archangels? Other traditions celebrate different numbers of archangels, but as Catholics, we celebrate the 3 mentioned in the Bible by name. These are St. Michael, St. Gabriel, and St. Raphael. Saint Michael is known for fighting Satan and casting him into Hell. Saint Gabriel is known in the bible for appearing to Mary at the annunciation to tell her that she was going to have baby Jesus. Saint Raphael is known for being a healer, and is mentioned in the book of Tobit.

Why Do We Call Archangels Saints? Well a "Saint" is just someone that is in heaven with Jesus, and the Archangels are.

How Can We Celebrate The Feast Of The Archangels With Catholic Kids? Often, these feast days are traditionally connected to seasonal foods and activities, as is Michaelmas. Pick some festivities that appeal to you and your family. This could include prayers, special foods, songs, crafts, or other celebrations. There is no magic formula. Celebrate!
